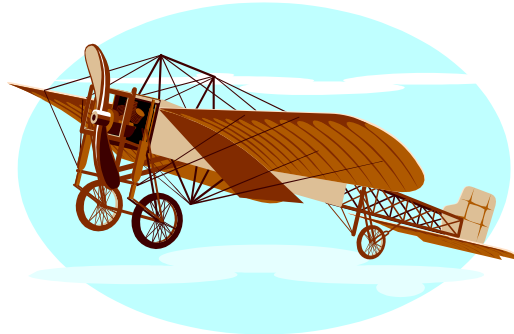

### Article III
